The AAUW (American Association of University Women) Medford Area Branch will accept applications for a student scholarship of up to \$750 to attend the three-day AAUW National Conference for College Women Student Leaders (**NCCWSL**) which will be held from May 29 through June 1, 2019 in College Park, MD. Applications will be accepted through January 15, 2019 from full-time college undergraduate students with junior status, or full-time or part-time graduate students.

Eligibility

1. Be a resident of Burlington County, NJ.
2. Must be a full-time, matriculated undergraduate student with junior status or a full-time or part-time matriculated graduate student enrolled at an accredited four-year college or university.
3. Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 for undergraduate students or 3.5 for graduate students.

Application Process

1. Complete and sign the application form.
2. Submit a typed, double-spaced essay of approximately 500 words. In your essay, please address the following:
 - a. Describe your quest for a college education.
 - b. Include how this scholarship to the **NCCWSL** conference will help you in achieving your goals.
3. Provide your most recent official school transcript(s) regardless of the age of the transcript(s).
4. Provide a completed recommendation form AND a recent letter of recommendation from one of your college professors who can speak to your character, qualities, and career aspirations. **The letter must be typed, signed, and dated** and include the name, title, address, phone number, and the relationship to the applicant of the person making the recommendation. This is a very important part of the application since it will give the AAUW committee a clear sense of your character and resolve.
